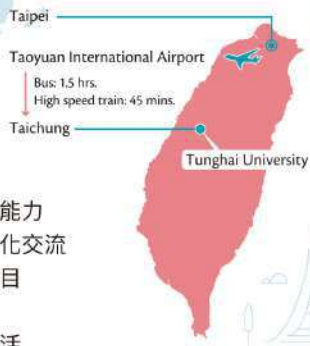

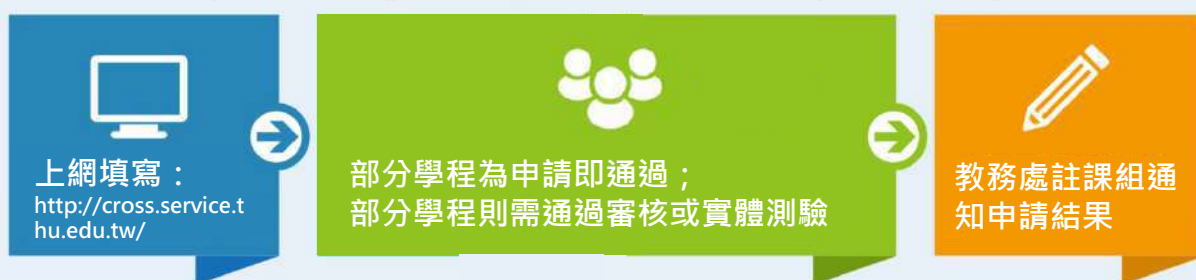

Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

Q: Is the GEP student required to study at Rutgers University in years 4 and 5?

No. The GEP student chooses to study at one of the GEP partner schools worldwide in years 4 and 5 or to complete four years of study at Tunghai University. The list of GEP partner schools is updated regularly.

Q: Why is there an additional annual GEP enrollment fee over the study at Tunghai University?

The annual GEP enrollment fee aims to enhance global mobility for the GEP student through multicultural exposures, intensive TOEFL/IELTS/GMAT courses, and personal study and career advice.

Q: Are all courses taught in English for the GEP student over the study at Tunghai University?

No. The department core courses required for the GEP student are mostly taught in Chinese. As these courses are taught later, the international student in the GEP program benefits from easier adaptation and makes progress in the Chinese language more smoothly over the study in Taiwan.

Q: Is there any upper limit on admissions to the GEP partner school?

No. The GEP application to the partner school is examined individually without competing against regular applicants worldwide. The admission is not guaranteed, however. With continual and close supervision by the GEP instructors and personal study advisor, successful application is highly expected.

Q: Can the GEP student change the major in the second degree at the partner school?

Yes. The student can apply for any major offered by the partner school but is required to take sufficient courses related to the initial major for completing the first degree at Tunghai University.

Q: Can the GEP student quit the GEP program and transfer back to the regular program?

Yes. But the student having quit the GEP program is not allowed to re-enter.

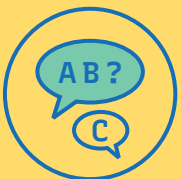

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I. 招生系所資訊

1. 修業年限

學士班為 4 至 6 年 (建築系修業年限為 5-7 年)。

2. 招生名額及招收對象

113 學年度學士班新生總招生名額共 110 位。

3. 招生系所

本校學士班有文學院、理學院、工學院、管理學院、社會科學院、農學院、創意設計暨藝術學院、法律學院及國際學院等九大學院，詳細內容請參考「IV.系所分則」。

II. 申請資格

僑生及港澳學生申請資格係依據教育部「僑生回國就學及輔導辦法」及「香港澳門居民來臺就學辦法」之規定，辦法如經修訂，以教育部公告為準，網址：<http://www.edu.tw/>。

1. 身分規定

申請者以當年度自海外回國者為限 (不含已在臺就讀高級中等學校、國內大學一年級肄業及國立臺灣師範大學僑生先修部結業之僑生及港澳生)。

- (1) **僑生**：海外出生連續居留迄今，或最近連續居留海外六年以上，並取得僑居地永久或長期居留證件回國就學之華裔學生。
- (2) **港澳生**：香港或澳門 (以下簡稱港澳) 居民，具有港澳永久居留資格證件，且最近連續居留境外六年以上者；並符合「香港澳門關係條例」第四條規定，未持有外國護照者。
- (3) **港澳具外國國籍之華裔學生**：具外國國籍，兼具香港或澳門永久居留資格，未曾在臺設有戶籍，且最近連續居留香港、澳門或海外 6 年以上之華裔學生申請入學大學，於相關法律修正施行前，其就學及輔導得準用「僑生回國就學及輔導辦法」規定申請入學。

註1：取得僑居地永久或長期居留證件，得以取得僑居地公民權、永久居留權或以其所持中華民國護照已加簽僑居身分認定之。

註2：「香港澳門關係條例」第四條規定，所稱香港居民係指具有香港永久居留資格，且未持有英國國民 (海外) 護照或香港護照以外之旅行證照者；所稱澳門居民係指具有澳門永久居留資格，且未持有澳門護照以外之旅行證照或雖持葡萄牙護照但係於葡萄牙結束治理前於澳門取得者。

註3：所稱境外，指台灣地區以外之國家；所稱海外，指大陸地區、香港及澳門以外之國家或地區。

註4：所謂「連續居留」係指「每曆年 (1月1日至12月31日) 在臺灣地區停留期間不得逾120日，期間係以本簡章申請時間截止日為計算基準日往前回溯推算六年。但計算至西元2024年8月31日始符合本簡章所訂連續居留年限規定者，亦得申請。申請人如符合下列情形之一者，不以連續僑居中斷論；其在臺灣地區停留期間不併入港澳或海外居留期間計算 (意指港澳或海外連續居留時間須往前推算)。請於報名時檢附證明文件一併繳交，以利審核。

- (1) 就讀僑務主管機關舉辦之海外青年技術訓練班或中央主管教育行政機關認定之技術訓練專班。
- (2) 參加僑務主管機關主辦或其認定屬政府機關舉辦之活動，或就讀主管機關核准境外招生之華語教育機構開設之華語文研習課程，其活動或研習期間合計未滿二年。
- (3) 交換學生，其交換期間合計未滿二年。
- (4) 經中央目的事業主管機關許可來臺實習，實習期間合計未滿二年。

- (5) 回國接受兵役徵召及服役。
- (6) 因戰亂、天災或大規模傳染病，致無法返回僑居地。
- (7) 因其他不可歸責於僑生之事由，致無法返回僑居地，有證明文件。

註5：僑生身分認定，由僑務主管機關為之；港澳生及港澳具外國國籍之華裔學生身分認定，由教育部為之。

註6：僑生及港澳生在臺就讀期間因故自願退學返回僑居地且在臺停留未滿二年，得予重新申請回國就學，並以一次為限。惟曾在國內大專院校（含國立臺灣師範大學僑生先修部）註冊在學、休學、非因故自願退學（如勒令退學）及申請保留入學資格有案者不得申請，如有違反此規定經查證屬實者，撤銷其錄取資格。

註7：僑生及港澳生回國就學期間，除其他法令另有規定外，不得任意變更身分。

註8：若同時符合外國學生及僑生身分資格者，請擇一身分申請入學，一旦提出申請後不得變更身分。

註9：本項招生對象不含緬甸、泰北地區未立案華文中學畢業僑生。

2. 學歷規定

- (1) 在當地華文中學、外文中學畢業或相當於國內高級中學畢業取得畢業證書（以同等學力資格申請者，須檢附修業證明書），且經我政府駐外機構或僑務委員會指定之保薦單位查證屬實者。
- (2) 相當於國內高級中等學校肄業或畢業年級高於相當國內高級中學學校之國外同級同類學校肄業並修滿相當於國內高級中學學校修業年限以下年級，符合下列資格之一者，或畢業年級相當於國內高級中等學校二年級之國外同級同類學校畢業生，得以同等學力資格申請：
 - A. 僅未修習規定修業年限最後一年，因故休學、退學或重讀二年以上。

Undergraduate programs must be completed within 4 to 6 years (programs in the Department of Architecture must be completed within 5 to 7 years).

Tunghai University has 9 colleges (College of Arts, College of Science, College of Engineering, College of Management, College of Social Sciences, College of Agriculture, College of Fine Arts and Creative Design, College of Law, and International College). II. Entry Requirements

All rules and regulations indicated in this brochure regarding the qualifications for Overseas Chinese, Hong Kong, and Macau students who intent to apply for admission to THU are subject to the “Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan” and “Regulations Regarding Hong Kong and Macau Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” administered by Ministry of Education (MOE) of R.O.C. Should there be any future revisions made in the regulations, the latest regulations announced by MOE shall prevail.

1. Identification Documents

Applicants are limited only to those who return to Taiwan from abroad in the current year (exclusive of those who have studied in senior high schools in Taiwan; those who have studied for one year in a domestic university; and the overseas Chinese, Hong Kong, and Macau students who have been certified by the Division of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students of National Taiwan Normal University).

- (1) “**Overseas Chinese Students**” refers to students of Chinese descent who have been living abroad since birth until the present time, or who have been living overseas for at least six consecutive years in the immediate past and have obtained permanent or long-term residency status overseas.
- (2) “**Hong Kong and Macau Students**” refers to students 1) who have permanent residency of Hong Kong or Macau; and 2) who have been living overseas for at least six consecutive years in the immediate past; and 3) who, according to Article 4 of Laws and Regulations Regarding Hong Kong & Macao Affairs, do not have any other foreign passports.
- (3) “**Hong Kong and Macau Chinese Students with Foreign Nationality**” refers to overseas Chinese students with foreign nationalities, possessing permanent residency of Hong Kong or Macau and have been living there for at least six consecutive years in the immediate past—without a household registration in Taiwan; before related laws are amended and enacted, the counseling assistance for the aforementioned students is conducted according to the “Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan” when they apply for university admission.

- Note. 1. Documentary evidence of having obtained permanent or long-term residency status overseas referred to proof of having citizenship or permanent residency in the applicant's country of residence, or having a Republic of China passport which officially records the person's overseas Chinese status.
- Note. 2. In Article 4 of "Laws and Regulations Regarding Hong Kong & Macao Affairs," the term "Hong Kong Residents" as used herein refers to persons who qualify for permanent residency in Hong Kong and who do not hold a travel document other than a British (Overseas) passport or a Hong Kong passport. The term "Macau Residents" as used herein refers to those who have the right of permanent residency in Macau and hold no travel documents other than the Macau passport with the exception of a Portuguese passport obtained prior to the end of Portuguese rule in Macau.
- Note. 3. The term "abroad" refers to countries or regions other than Taiwan; "overseas" refers to countries or regions other than mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau.
- Note. 4. The term "consecutive years of overseas residency" includes calendar years in each of which a Hong Kong, Macau, or overseas Chinese student has not spent more than 120 days in Taiwan. The standard way to calculate the period of continuous overseas residency is to trace back to the preceding 6 years from the final date for admission application stated in this admission brochure. **A grace period** of extension, however, can be set on August 31, 2018 as the counting backward date for the six required years of continuous residency. Continuous overseas residency **could include** the time that a person has spent in Taiwan when the following cases occur (please provide proof)—if a student:
- (1) attended an overseas youth technical training course conducted by the OCAC or a technical professional training program accredited by an authorized educational administration authority;
 - (2) attended an activity held by the OCAC or by a government agency recognized by the OCAC; or has taken a Chinese language course (not exceeding a total period of two years) provided by a Chinese language education institute approved by the governing authority to recruit overseas students;
 - (3) spent a total period of less than two years in Taiwan as an exchange student;
 - (4) spent a total period of less than two years for an internship in Taiwan under the approval of the designated national authority;
 - (5) returned to Taiwan for military service;
 - (6) stayed in Taiwan because of war, natural disaster, or a major outbreak of an infectious disease; or
 - (7) stayed in Taiwan because of matters that the student was not responsible for and with documents of proof.
- Note. 5. The aforementioned citizenship and permanent residency documentation must include proof of citizenship from the applicant's country of residence, proof of permanent residency, or a Taiwanese passport with a valid overseas status.
- Note. 6. Overseas Chinese Students who have been studying at a Taiwan university for less than two year and have discontinued their studies in order to return to their countries of origin, must repeat the application process; only one such reapplication is permitted. However, *this does not apply to those* who were once enrolled in, dropped out from, or expelled from domestic universities or colleges (including the Division of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students in National Taiwan Normal University) and those who have had the record of applying for admission postponement. If violations of this regulation are found and verified, the admission qualification will be voided.
- Note. 7. During the course of study, Hong Kong, Macau, and Overseas Chinese Students may not change their student status, unless otherwise permitted by other regulatory functions.
- Note. 8. For those who are eligible to apply as both international students and overseas Chinese students, please choose only one identity to apply. Once the application is submitted, no changes of identity will be allowed.
- Note. 9. The above admission regulations do not include overseas Chinese students who graduated from unincorporated Chinese schools in Myanmar and Northern Thailand.

2. Academic Credentials

- (1) Certificated graduates from foreign/overseas Chinese high schools, high schools taught in foreign languages, or schools with a status equivalent to domestic high schools may apply (all such must include an enrollment certificate) and verified by the Republic of China's overseas missions or the Overseas Community Affairs Council.
- (2) Students can apply with a high school equivalency certificate if they: 1) attended a school in a foreign country, Hong Kong, or Macao of a comparable academic level and nature to senior high schools in Taiwan, but which requires more years of study, or 2) if they, though graduated from their secondary studies there, yet the graduating year is only equivalent to the 11th grade of a senior high school program in Taiwan. More details are listed as the following:
 - A. The student completed all but the final year due to an application for a suspension or withdrawal, or if they had resumed study above the 2nd year of a senior high school.
 - B. The student completed the first semester of the final year of the prescribed program but for some reason suspended or withdrew for one year or more.
 - C. The student completed the prescribed program but for some reason was unable to graduate.

The number of years for suspension, withdrawal, or resumption of schooling count from the end-date of the last semester that the student completed, as recorded in the transcript of all finished academic years, the certificate of enrollment, or the certificate of withdrawal, until the ending date of registration in which the entrance examination takes place.

- (3) Applicant shall obtain an equivalent education level to meet the qualification of the regulation of "Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission" by the MOE.
- (4) Applicants to which the following cases apply will be disqualified for admission or expelled and deprived of student status if already enrolled:
 - A. Who have not yet acquired foreign nationalities after application for cancellation of R.O.C nationality with approval
 - B. Whose applications or passports have been forged, altered, fabricated, and hence fraudulent, inaccurate, or otherwise lacking legal validity
 - C. Whose qualifications have been verified by OCAC or MOE to be ineligible after admission

Note 1. Graduating applicants should provide a "Certificate of Expected Graduation" or proof of current enrollment. Once accepted, however, official diploma is required to avoid cancellation of admission.

Note 2. An applicant (from a high school in Hong Kong, Macao or other areas), whose graduating year is equivalent to the sophomore year of a senior high school in Taiwan (please refer to Form 5 for senior high finishing at the 11th grade), is eligible to apply for the undergraduate program. However, the student will have to take an extra 12 credits to satisfy the graduation requirement according to "Tunghai University Academic Regulations."

Any confirmed violation of the above will lead to cancellation of admission, expulsion from school and diploma revocation. THU will not issue any proof of academic credentials at any stage.

V. Admission Announcement

1. Enrollment Policies

Early Action	Applicant who has enrolled at THU will not be admitted by the “University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students”.
Regular Action	Applicant who has been admitted by the “University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students” will not be admitted by THU.

- (1). Applicants having overseas Chinese status and Hong Kong/Macau students or Hong Kong/Macau students with foreign nationalities confirmed and approved by the overseas Chinese Affairs Administration or by the Taiwan Ministry of Education, who have been accepted by the department to which they applied, will be submitted to the THU Admissions Committee for final admission.
- (2). Each department’s minimum admission criteria will be decided by the THU Admissions Committee. Applicants who reach the minimum admission criteria and fall within the admission quota will be listed as officially admitted students.
- (3). Applicants with the same grades will be listed according to the reference standard. The reference standard will first refer to the “other supplementary documents” submitted by the applicants.
- (4). Applicants applying to two programs will be admitted to the program listed as their priority. If officially admitted by the priority program, the applicant’s other officially admitted will be revoked.

2. Application Results

Applicants can log onto the online application system to check their personal application results during the designated period of time.

3. Enquiry on Results

After releasing the admission list within 7 days, please visit the application website and click on “Download” to download and print out the “Result Enquiry Application Form”, and email it to admission@thu.edu.tw or fax to the THU Center for Strategic Recruitment Office of Academic Affairs +886-4-23596334. The application is free of charge.

- (1). Applicants can only request an enquiry on result once. Applicants cannot request the office to offer information such as grades of an individual item, accessing or copying documents regarding grades, nor can the applicants request to know the name or other related information of individuals in the reviewing committee. The enquiry on result only checks if there are miscalculations or missed review items.
- (2). If the enquiry result shows that an applicant who wasn’t admitted actually fits the admission standard, then the applicant will be admitted. If the enquiry result shows that an applicant who was admitted but doesn’t fit the admission standard, then the applicant will be disqualified. The disqualified applicant must comply.
- (3). After the enquiry result has come out, the result will be sent to the applicant via email.

4. Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies

Applicants who receive the notification of admission issued by THU are required to submit the “Acceptance Form of Admission for Overseas Chinese, Hong Kong and Macau Students” to the Office of International Relations (OIR) to complete the enrollment process. Failure to reply the letter will result in cancellation of students’ admission and other related services by THU and no objection will be accepted.

5. Mailing Letters of Admission Notification

After the announcement of application results, we will notify the applicants by email and mail out the official notification of admission.

VI. Enrollment and Registration

Freshmen who have completed checking in should come to the campus at the specified time on the admission notification (around early September 2024) and go through the enrollment procedures. Those who failed to finish the enrollment will be seen as giving up on the enrollment qualification.

【Overseas Chinese】

- (1) Original of passport.
- (2) Original of permanent or long-term residential permit in applicant's country.
- (3) Original of the senior high school graduation diploma authenticated by the Republic of China overseas mission or verified by units designated by the Overseas Community Affairs Council (or equivalent proof of academic qualifications). [Graduation certificates issued by Taiwan Schools overseas do not require authentication or verification.]
- (4) Original of the senior high school transcripts authenticated by the Republic of China overseas mission or verified by units designated by the Overseas Community Affairs Council.
- (5) One 2-inch front-facing photo showing the upper body (without hat), taken within the last 6 months.

【Hong Kong or Macau students, Hong Kong/Macau students with foreign nationalities】

- (1) Original of passport.
- (2) Original of permanent residential permit in Hong Kong or Macau.
- (3) Original of continuous residence proof in Hong Kong or Macau.
- (4) Original of the senior high school graduation diploma authenticated by the Republic of China overseas mission or verified by units designated by the Overseas Community Affairs Council (or equivalent proof of academic qualifications). [Graduation certificates issued by Taiwan Schools overseas do not require authentication or verification.]
- (5) Original of the senior high school transcripts authenticated by the Republic of China overseas mission or verified by units designated by the Overseas Community Affairs Council.
- (6) One 2-inch front-facing photo showing the upper body (without hat), taken within the last 6 months.

2. Related Rules of Studying in Taiwan

- (1) If the admitted student has been ruled by the Overseas Chinese Affairs Administration or the Taiwan Ministry of Education of not qualified as an overseas Chinese student, Hong Kong/Macau student or Hong Kong/Macau student with a foreign nationality, the University will revoke the student's admission qualification. There will be no objection.
- (2) **A study permit does not equal to a visa, a visa will have to be issued by the Republic of China's Ministry of Foreign Affairs overseas embassies.**
- (3) Overseas Chinese students, Hong Kong/Macau students, and Hong Kong/Macau students with foreign nationalities who have entered this University by this admission cannot: transfer or pursue further education by admitting to other schools of continuing education, distance education, recurrent education programs offered by colleges, in-service education program and other classes offered only at night time or on weekends. But ones who have obtained Taiwanese legal residential permit by non-educational purposes are not restrained by this rule. Overseas Chinese and Hong Kong/Macau students who violate the rules listed previously will be revoked of their self-implemented transfer college student or higher student status. Also, no academic proof will be provided by the THU. If any condition indicated above is unfolded after international students have graduated from THU, they will be ordered by the university to hand in the

certificate of their degree obtained from THU.

- (4) According to regulations from the Taiwan Immigration Department, the admitted Hong Kong/Macau students must pass a detained physical examination to apply for a residential permit. The examination items (forms) and the medical facility conducting the examination follows the regulations of the Taiwan Ministry of Health and Welfare.

Notes: People with Republic of China identity cards would not need to be detained for physical examination.

- (5) The admitted students can apply for an exit and entry permit by using the "online system for foreigners" (commonly shortened to the cloud system). Be sure to bring admission letter to Taiwan so that you can able to apply for a residential permit.
- (6) According to regulations from the Taiwan Immigration Department, Hong Kong/Macau students who are 20 years old or above upon the day of arrival must have a certificate of non-criminal record or a Police Clearance Certificate of sorts. (Must be authenticated by a Taiwan overseas representative office) to be able to apply for a residential permit.
- (7) The THU Office of International Relations will buy an "Overseas Chinese Accident and Sickness Insurance" for all overseas students after the semester had started. People who reside over 180 days without departing more than once (single departure can be no longer than 30 days), would meet the requirement of being included in the Republic of China National Health Insurance. If students couldn't be included in the National Health Insurance because one hasn't met the requirement yet, the office will help to get an overseas students accident and sickness insurance until the student meets the requirement. Note: Hong Kong/Macau students' health insurance's required days of residence start counting from the day the students obtained a residential permit. Non-Hong Kong/Macau overseas Chinese students' residential days start counting from the day of arrival.

VII. Applicants Complaints and Handling

1. Applicants who think that the exam results have violated their rights or have violated the gender equality principles should file a written complaint to the THU Admissions Committee within seven days of the release of the admission result.
2. The complaint should include the applicant's first and last name, the applicant's applied program, home address, phone numbers, date of complaint, facts, and reason of complaint and include related documents or evidence.
3. If the following items apply to the applicant's complaint, then the complaint will not be processed.
 - (1) The complaint is included clearly in the admission related laws or in this handbook.
 - (2) Applicant failed to meet the deadline or the applicant is not applicable.
4. The accepted complaint will be answered by the admissions committee within one month. If necessary, the Dean of academic affairs will assemble Deans of each department, legal adviser, and related personnel to form a task force to justly investigate and handle the problem.
5. The number of times an applicant can file a complaint is limited to once.

VIII. Other Related Information

1. To make sure that you are qualified for application in accordance with Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan **and** Measures for Hong Kong and Macau Residents Studying in Taiwan, part of your personal information will be sent to OCAC, University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students, MOE, and Ministry of the Interior (to check your entry record).
2. **The admission notification issued by THU does not guarantee the applicant's acquisition of an R.O.C. visa. This will be processed and issued by an overseas embassy, consulate, or mission abroad of the R.O.C. as authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.**
3. If it is found that admitted students do not meet the requirements for enrollment, or that submitted documents or certificates (including degree certificates, transcripts, extracurricular activities, or other relevant certificates) are forged, falsified, used under false pretenses, used fraudulently, inaccurate, or altered, the University shall revoke the eligibility for admission or expel students who are already enrolled. Students shall be liable for legal consequences, and no proof of studies issued. If it is discovered after the student has graduated from the University, aside from repealing the student's graduation certificate, an announcement will make revoking the student's legibility for graduation.
4. Overseas Chinese students who has (or had) household registration in Taiwan should apply for military service deferment during the school years. Conscription Regulations for Naturalized Aliens & Returning Overseas Chinese is applicable to Overseas Chinese students. Students who is not Overseas Chinese student any more is applicable to Conscription Law. For more conscription information, please check out the website of National Conscription Agency, Ministry of the Interior.
5. Overseas parents should appoint one relative in Taiwan as guardian.
6. For those students who are expelled by the school due to misbehavior or failure on academic performances should return to their original residence at their own expense.
7. Matters of overseas Chinese students maintaining their admission status, transferring to other schools, changing major, suspending or discontinuing their schooling and other matters concerning to student status, course work ,and life on campus are handled in accordance with "Tunghai University Academic Regulations" and relevant laws.
8. Freshman or transfer students no matter departments, nationalities and genders are required to take one-school-year labor education (zero credit).
9. Undergraduates should take courses according to each department's requirement. Furthermore, students are required to pass the English proficiency tests regulated by each department or meet others requirements in order to graduate.
10. The admitted students who graduate from a foreign high school(including those in Hong Kong and Macao)which is considered equivalent to senior high school sophomores in Taiwan are required to complete 12 extra credits for the completion of a bachelor's degree in accordance with "Tunghai University Academic Regulations". Please check the website of THU periodically for the latest regulations pertaining to enrollment applications as needed.
11. The guide is according to Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan, Measures for Hong Kong and Macau Residents Studying in Taiwan, Tunghai University Academic Regulations and Tunghai University overseas Chinese, Hong Kong and Macau students Undergraduate Programs Admission Regulations.
12. Issues which are not covered by the Guide will be handled according to the relevant University regulations or a decision reached by the Admissions Committee.

3. Way of gathering personal information:
The examination candidates’ personal information obtained via the personal delivery, the mail delivery, the fax or online registration.
4. Types of personal information gathered:
Include name, ID or ARC or Passport number, birthday, photo, gender, educational information, emergency contact person, address, email address, contact information, transfer account, proof of the low-income or the middle-low-income family. The statutory types of personal information (Note) are: C001, C002, C003, C011, C021, C023, C033, C034, C038, C051, C052, C056, C057, C061, C062, C064, C072, C111, C132.
5. Handling and use of personal information:
 - (1) Utilizing period:
The utilizing period is the required duration of completing the aforementioned information gathering apart from the expiration date of the personal information for the tests conducted by the ordinance or the central division authority’s additional regulation.
 - (2) The region within which personal information will be used:
Taiwan (including Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu) or places where handling and use has been approved by the examination candidates.
 - (3) Users of personal information:
The units of the School and the relevant cooperative units of completing the aforementioned information gathering, including the Ministry of Education or other administrative, academic and research institutions.
 - (4) Way of using:
 - a. The required exposure (announcement) based on the public trust of the test service, the academic research and other necessary methods for achieving the aforementioned collection objectives due to the School’s proceeding of the test service, admitting, registering, approval, enrollment and students management, contacting the examination candidates (or parents and guardians).
 - b. The School is allowed to provide the personal or relevant information to the related authority or judiciary by the regulation or the demand of the authority or judiciary by law.
6. The false, incorrect and incomplete personal information will cause the failure of registering the test, contacting for emergency, and delivering the grades, and that influence the examination candidates’ rights of testing, follow-up test service and accepting the test service. The examination candidates should confirm all provided personal information to be true and correct. If there is any false or requiring alteration, please submit the relevant documentary identification to the Admissions Section, Office of Academic Affairs of the School for the application of correction.
7. In accordance within the Act, the examination candidates can inquire about the information or request to read it, ask for copies, supplement, correct, ask to cease the gathering, use and handling, and for deletion. The examination candidates can exercise the above rights by submitting a hard copy in writing, by fax and by phone with this request to the School (Please check the Registration Requirements for the contacting information). The request of ceasing the gathering, use and handling and for deletion must not obstruct the School’s duty by law.

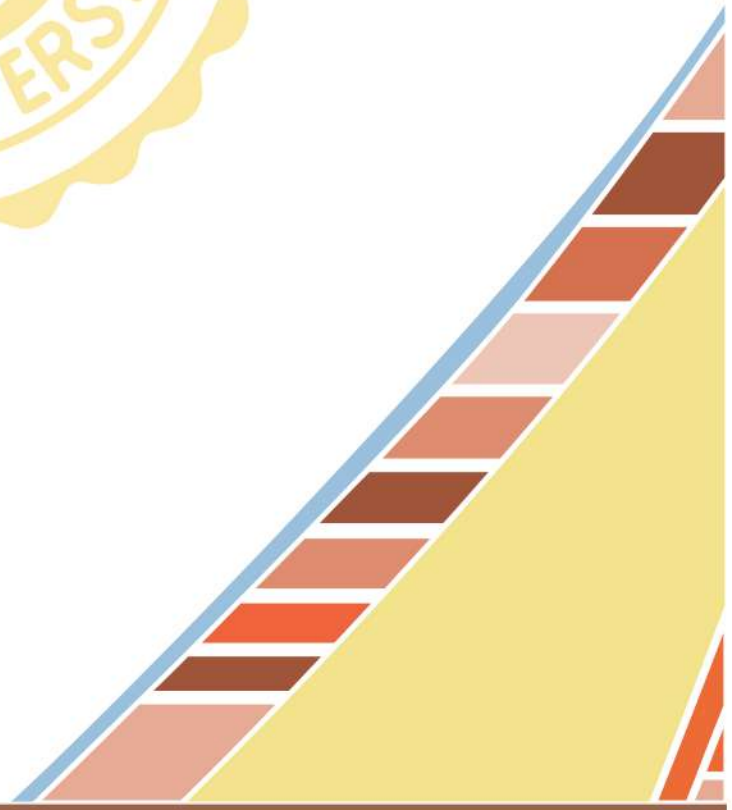
